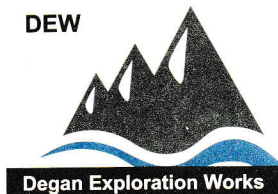



**SUBJECT: FORMAL APPROVAL OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR

Reference your application dated 14.9.2018 on the above noted subject.

This is to inform you that the University Consultancy Committee in its meeting held on 19.9.2018 chaired by the Vice Chancellor, vetted the proposed agreement submitted by you and allowed you to provide consultancy services as per provisions in the contract agreement for "Prospect-III Mine Plan and Design at Shinkai / Degan Copper Mining Project NW MEDO, FWO" in accordance to the provisions contained in Sections 19 to 22 of the UET, Peshawar Rules/Regulations of Private Consultancy, reproduced below:-

- "19. University employees will be allowed to provide advisory and Consultancy services in their private capacity, subject to prior permission from the Vice-Chancellor, provided their normal duties will not suffer.
20. University employees who are allowed by the University to provide Consultancy services in their private capacity shall deposit a fee with the University at the rate of Rs. One thousand per annum.
21. University employees who are allowed by the University to provide consultancy services will give an undertaking to the effect that:
 - i. Their teaching, administrative and other duties at the University will not suffer.
 - ii. They will fulfill all the contractual agreement with their client.
 - iii. The University employee (s) will submit to Registrar a copy of the proposed contract agreement between the employee and his Client for vetting by the University Consultancy Committee.
 - iv. No assignment shall be taken by the employee without the permission of the Vice-Chancellor and without the contract agreement properly vetted by the University. This will also stand applicable to University teachers taking classes in other private Institutions in the afternoon. No teacher of the University is allowed to teach in other Institutions in the morning.

v. 10% of the contract amount payable to the employee/fee/salary /honoraria shall be paid to the University as a goodwill fee. U.E.T. teachers teaching in the evening/second shift in UET will be exempted from charging goodwill fee.

22. Permission granted to such employees will be withdrawn if the services provided to the client by the University employees were not good and below the mark."

Further, the University shall have no responsibility towards the technical matters of the project or any outcome. Any issue pertains to these shall be your sole responsibility and shall be at your own risk and cost.

Accordingly, you are required to submit a copy of the contract agreement duly signed by both parties to the undersigned for reference and record.
