

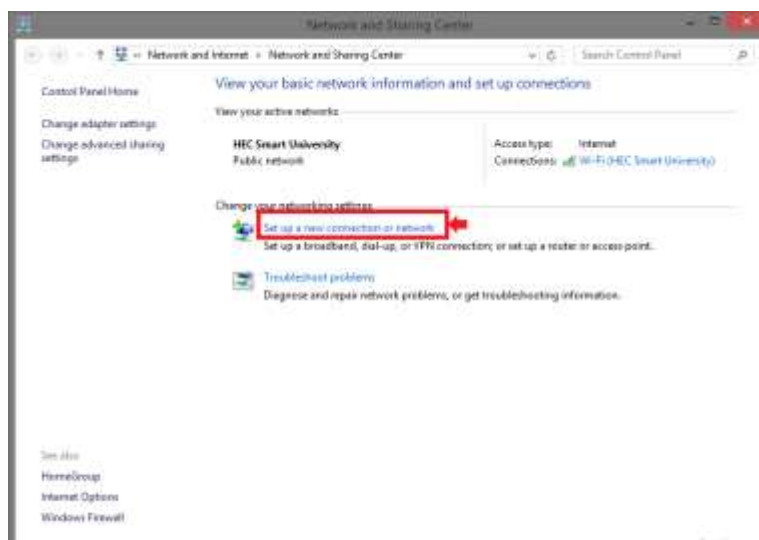


Windows 8 Configuration of HEC Smart University Connectivity Manual

- Open 'Network and Sharing '

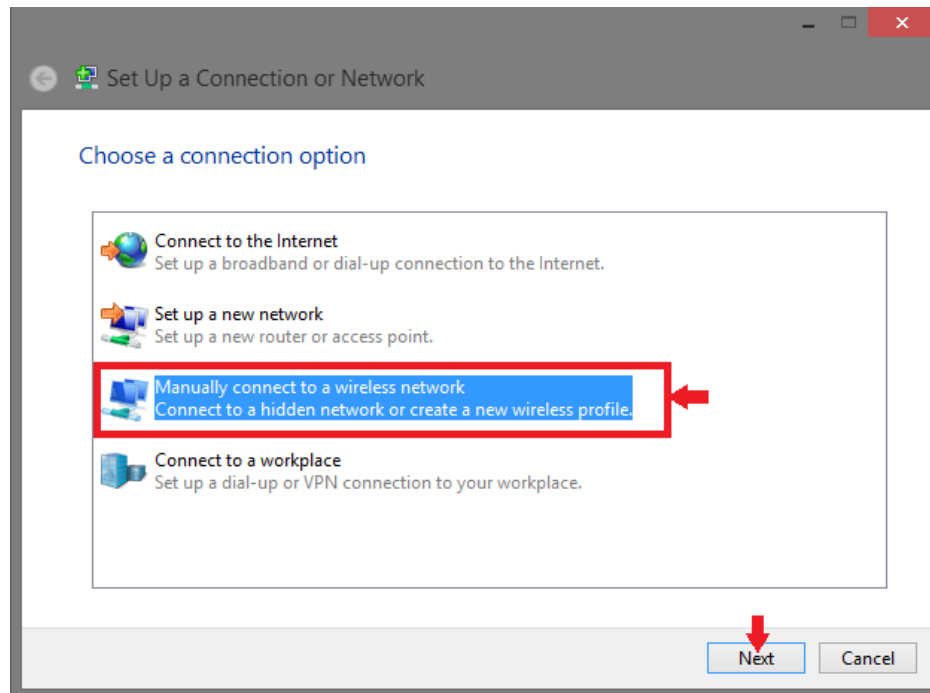


- Go to 'Set up a new connection or network''





- Choose 'Manually connect to a wireless network'





- On network name write “HEC Smart University”
- Security type ‘WPA-Enterprise’
- Leave Security Key ‘Blank’
- Click on ‘Next’

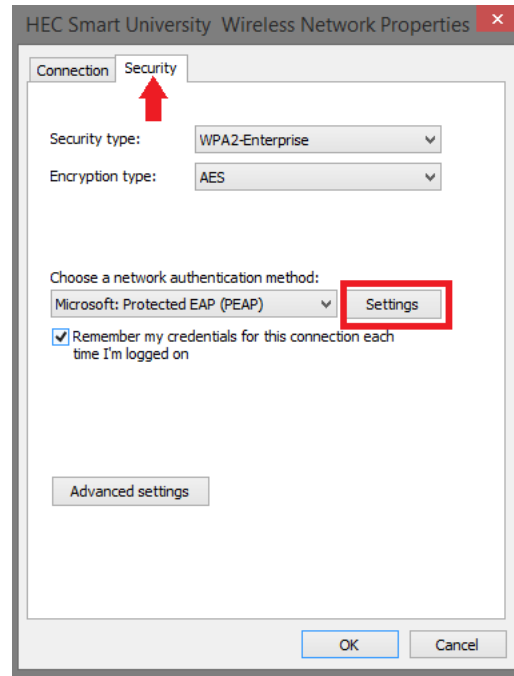

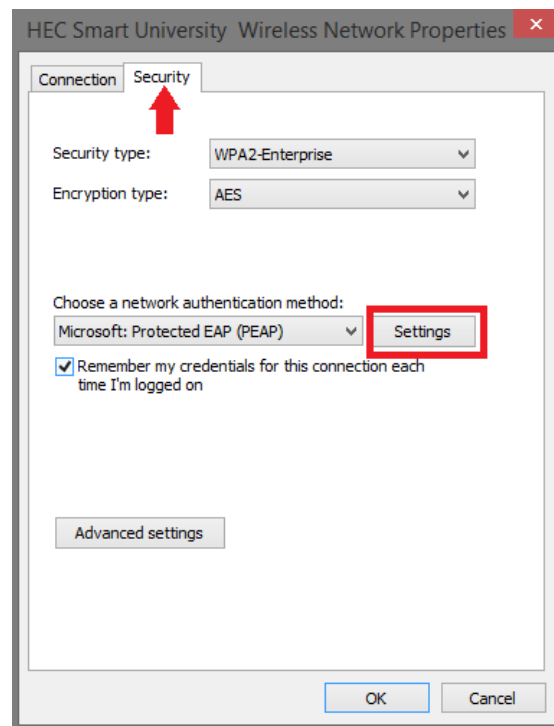

- Network Authentication Method: Microsoft: Protected EAP (PEAP) and then click setting

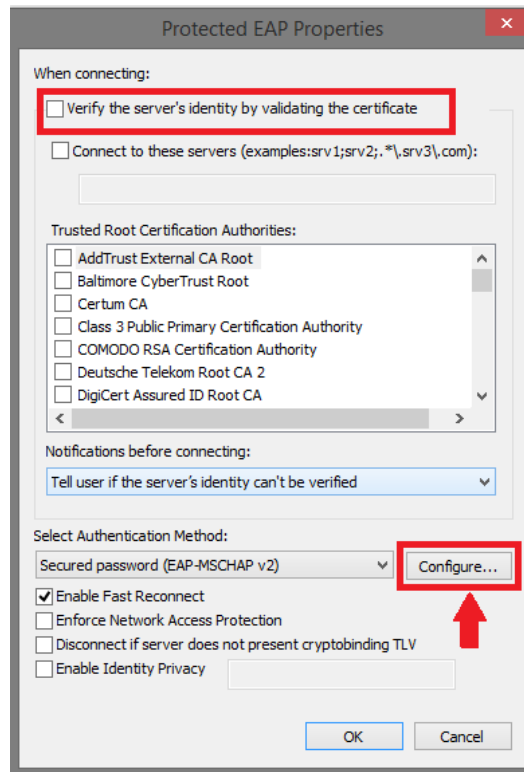


- Go to 'Security' Tab

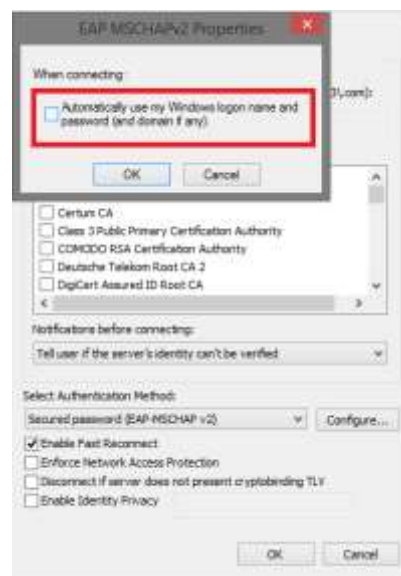




- Uncheck 'Validate server certificate'

- Uncheck 'Automatically use my windows logon name and password (and domain if any)' press OK



- Press 'Ok'



- Forget/Disconnect all Networks
- Enter your Institute ID and Password. Your user ID must be appended with @hec.gov.pk (e.g. test@hec.gov.pk).
