


Configuring “UET-HOTSPOT” on an Android device


The following instructions are for configuring the “UET-HOTSPOT” service for generic Android as provided on Google Nexus phones and tablets.

Please follow these steps:

1. From the home screen go to the **Wi-Fi Settings**:




2. The Wi-Fi screen will load and display a list of available networks. Tap **“UET-HOTSPOT”**:



If you do not see “UET-HOTSPOT” listed, please move to a location where “UET-HOTSPOT” is available. If you are unsure, please speak to your local IT support staff.

3. You will be prompted to sign in to the wireless network. Enter your credentials as shown below and tap **Connect** when complete - note that you may need to scroll down in the box to see the later options (this is sometimes not obvious):
 - o EAP Method: **PEAP** (if you cannot see this option, it might be revealed by selecting the **Show advanced options** box at the bottom)
 - o CA certificate: **(unspecified)**
 - o Identity: **Username [19pwele1111@uetp.edu.pk]**
 - o Password: **Your Passowrd**
 - o Show password: (you can tick this if you wish to check the password is entered correctly: it will have no effect on the eventual configuration)



4. You should now be connected to the “UET-HOTSPOT” network and this confirmed by the WiFi configuration menu
